THE ZEBRA PROJECT WITH MULTIPLE- CHARGED WAULSORTIAN MOUNDS

Thomasson Partner Associates is offering the Zebra Project which is part of a giant exploration play based on hundreds to thousands of Waulsortian mounds that appear on seismic data at depths of 3300-5000 ft. The Zebra Project is defined by a 10 BO/D Waulsortian mound show, multiple seismic lines displaying multiple Waulsortian mounds, and a surface geochemistry survey displaying multiple anomalies suggesting that multiple charged Waulsortian mounds underlie the project.

Source rocks include thick Cambrian shales and the basal Mississippian Exshaw-Bakken Shale. The project is in an area of almost all fee acreage estimated to be in the \$25/acre range.

If interested, we will send a Zebra Project Panel that displays 3 seismic lines with Waulsortian mounds. We are seeking a partner interested in a 37,000 acre project from which to expand into a surrounding giant play in the Rocky Mountain region.

A confidentiality agreement and a noncompete agreement are required prior to a showing here in Denver.
